Public Works Report was reviewed. Brush pile has been ground; cut down volunteer trees; mowed and sprayed; painted crosswalks; repaired W. 3<sup>rd</sup> St. water leak; trimmed trees by school.

Police Report was discussed.

- a. Fireworks Ordinance. Current ordinance needs clarification; Council discussed banning fireworks. Will discuss at September meeting.
- b. A 28E Agreement, Memorandum of Understanding between City of Aurelia and City of Marcus for Law Enforcement Services was discussed. After further discussion, Johnson made motion to approve, second by Redig. All members present voting “aye” motion carried.

Roman Redig and Luke Erpelding discussed Mercy Air Care membership program, it was found unwarranted.

Clerks Report was discussed.

A final written report from pool manager Myriah Noble was reviewed.

Redig made motion to approve renewal of liquor license for New Reflections, second by Johnson. All members present voting “aye” motion carried.

Curbside recycling for Aurelia residents was discussed.

Landfill was discussed.

There being no further business to discuss, meeting was adjourned.
