- Redig made motion to approve tax abatement for Kolin & Emily Peterson, second by Bruce. All members present voting “aye” motion carried. Absent: Nelson.

- Redig made motion to approve The Tap liquor license, second by Johnson. Roll call vote “aye”: Fassler, Redig, Johnson; “nay”: none. Motion carried. Absent: Nelson. Bruce abstained.
 - Johnson made motion to approve Fire Department Officers for 2022; Lucas Erpelding as Fire Chief; Roman Redig as 1st assistant chief; Mark Lindgren as 2nd assistant chief; Jim Bezoni as Safety Officer; Dustin Wieland as Foreman; Roger Redig as Secretary/Treasurer, second by Bruce. Roll call vote “aye”: Bruce, Johnson, Fassler. Absent: Nelson. Redig abstained.
