Redig made motion to approve Resolution #23-14 ***Resolution authorizing and approving a Loan and Disbursement Agreement providing for the issuance and securing the payment of \$595,000 Water Revenue Bonds, Series 2023*** second by Nelson. All members present voting "aye". Motion carried.

Nelson made motion to approve Resolution 23-15 ***Resolution Supporting Memorial Highway Signage In Honor of Specialist Brian Botello***, second by Johnson. All members present voting "aye". Motion Carried.

Nelson made motion to pledge \$250,000.00 for the construction toward a new fire station, 2nd by Redig. All members voting “aye”. Motion carried.
